

SAFE OPERATION OF YOUR SLIDING LOUVRE

Your sliding louvre has two different movements.

The first being sliding from side to side and the second being rotation of the louvre blades in the frame.

SLIDING YOUR LOUVRE – The louvre is very simple and easy to slide from side to side.

The slide bolt mounted on the side of the louvre frame controls a locating pin, which is used to lock your louvre in position.

To move your louvre to a new position simply pull down on the slide bolt and slide.

Always hold the slide bolt down and slowly walk the louvre to the desired position. Once the louvre is in the desired position release the slide bolt.

You will notice a number of holes inside the top track. These holes house the locating pin attached to the slide bolt.

It is advisable to always position your louvre into one of these holes, as it will stop the louvre from moving in high winds.

It is very important to never force the louvre as this will result in the slide bolt pin being damaged and void all warranty.

ROTATING YOUR BLADES – Your blades can be positioned to any angle required.

Simply use both hands (separate blades for vertical) from the middle of the bank of blades.

This evens the load of the control arm and allows the blades to move freely and smoothly.

If the blades are in the fully closed position and it is difficult to hold the blade, simply use the control arm to slightly open the blades and then go back to using both hands on the blade or blades to open your blades to the desired position.
